Community Seed Purchase

I am coordinating community seed purchases for Johnny's, Burpee and MI Gardener (seeds only, not for fertilizer, equipment or supplies) in mid-December and early January (see due dates below).

Here is how it will work:

- 1) Look at the seed catalogs (available online) and make your list. Please list the complete seed name as it appears, product ID number (if there is one), quantity, and an alternate choice (seed name, product ID number) if you are ok with a substitution because your first choice may be out of stock. Please also give me the phone number where I may reach you.
- 2) If you have any coupons, discounts or special deals that could be applied, please let me know. These will be applied to the overall order (not just to your specific order). I will apply the best discount that I have to the entire order.
- 3) Your orders should be sent to my email at ivynetzal@gmail.com with "Johnny's Seed Order", or "Burpee Seed Order" or "Mlgardener Seed Order" in the subject line.
- 4) I will send you a return email acknowledging that I received your order. If you don't see this email, check your SPAM folder. If you still don't see my receipt email, please contact me.
- 5) I will order the seeds on the day indicated and pay for the order using my credit card. If your order is not placed in time, you will miss out.
- 6) The seeds will be shipped to my home where I will separate them into your individual order.
- 7) Then payment of you share is due upon delivery of your order (cash or check). Please pay promptly.

If something you want is out of stock and you did not list an alternate choice, I will not order that seed for you. But hopefully we are ordering early enough so that this won't be a problem.

If we don't get enough orders to qualify for free shipping, we will divide the shipping costs equally. Burpee does not have free shipping, so we will just divide the shipping costs equally for this supplier.

Of course, we will have to pay sales tax on all orders and I will calculate individual sales tax amounts based on the amount of your specific order.

Johnnys order: Orders due Dec 19th. Ivy places the order Dec 20th. (free shipping for orders over \$200)

Burpee order: Orders due Dec 26th. Ivy places the order Dec 27th. (No free shipping. Shipping starts at \$9.95 and increases \$1 for every \$10 increase in order total, maxing out at \$19.95 for orders over \$150)

Mlgardener order: Orders due Jan 2nd. Ivy places the order January 3rd. (Free shipping for orders over \$19.99)

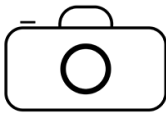
